

"Lucky Milo"

Overview: "Lucky Milo" is a documentary film centered on the life of US Marine Milo Imrie, a close friend of my son's who took his own life.

Marine Lance Corporal Milo Imrie might have become the next Steve Jobs or Elon Musk. Instead, he was found dead at age 29 in an Arizona motel. With an eloquent narration drawn from his written and video diaries, "Lucky Milo" chronicles Milo's astonishing odyssey: battling insurgents in Afghanistan, surviving the horrors of a broken US justice system, grappling heroically with traumatic brain injury (TBI) and PTSD, and searching for a cure to alleviate his suffering.

Although my wife Lisa and I produced the film and worked on it for two years, it is very much his son Ted's film. Milo, the central figure, was a close friend of his and Ted directed, shot, and edited the film. Ted is 32.

We feel we've made a deeply personal, extremely powerful documentary that has massive emotional impact while also engaging major societal questions about the wars we fight.
